THIS COURT FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

In accordance with California Rules of Court, rule 2.818, good cause exists for a waiver of the limitations set forth in subsection (b)(3) for temporary judges. Such good cause is established in order to meet the calendaring needs of the court and to increase access available to litigants in court proceedings. Thus, in family law cases, a temporary judge may hear a case wherein one party is self-represented and the other party is represented by counsel, as long as any required stipulation is received.

This order shall become effective on January 1, 2023, and expire on December 31, 2023, unless otherwise ordered by this court.
